

Confindustria Piacenza-Cesare Betti Scholarship 2023-2024 Academic Year IV edition

HAVING REGARD TO the letter of intent, our ref. no. 0138497 Tit. III Class. 12 dated 7 June 2024, with which Confindustria Piacenza expressed the desire to continue the study scholarship in memory of Dr Cesare Betti - Director of Confindustria Piacenza - who passed away on 14 March 2020, making available the total sum of \pounds 5,000.00 (five thousand) gross and all-inclusive of costs borne by Politecnico di Milano, in favour of a worthy graduate of the Laurea (equivalent to Bachelor of Science) programme in Mechanical Engineering or in Architectural Design at the Piacenza Campus of Politecnico di Milano who enrols on a Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) at Politecnico di Milano for the 2024/2025 a.y. by the set deadline.

HAVING REGARD TO the letter of acceptation the aforementioned letter of intent, our ref. no. 0140475 Tit. III Class. 12, dated 10 June 2024,

HEREBY DECREES

The issuance of the call for applications for 1 scholarship entitled "Confindustria Piacenza-Cesare Betti" – IV edition 2023/2024 a.y.

Art. 1 - Characteristics of the scholarship and admission requirements

The scholarship is for the gross value of Euro 5,000.00 (five thousand), inclusive of charges to be borne by Politecnico.

The "Confindustria Piacenza-Cesare Betti" scholarship is intended for graduates who have the following requirements at the call deadline:

- 1. Graduates in the July or September 2024 sessions on the Mechanical Engineering or Architectural Design programme delivered at the Piacenza Campus of Politecnico di Milano;
- 2. Enrolled in the 2021/2022 academic year on one of the aforementioned programmes;
- 3. Have a score average of at least 26/30;

Art. 2 - Participation methods

Applicants must submit an application using the special function available at online Services http://www.polimi.it/servizionline (Agevolazioni e Convenzioni > Borse di studio, premi di laurea, esoneri, [Subsidies and Conventions > Scholarships, Degree



awards, exonerations]) from 17 July 2024 and no later than 12pm (Italian time) on 4 November 2024.

The completion of the online application is equivalent to submitting an application for participation in this call for applications, and implies acceptance of its contents. It is the applicant's responsibility to check that the procedure has been completed correctly.

After having completed and submitted the application, the applicant may print a receipt and the application may no longer be altered. The applicant may delete the application and submit a fresh one before the deadline of the call.

Failure to complete and submit the application or submitting an incomplete application will result in the student being excluded from assessment.

Art. 3 - Assessable qualifications

The assignment of the scholarship is decided based on a ranking drawn up by the Piacenza Campus.

That ranking will be drawn up on the basis of the following criteria:

70% weighted average of all examinations involved in the study plan;

30% economic conditions (Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator

and gross family income).

If there are equal marks, the scholarship will be assigned to the applicant with the highest average.

If the scholarship is not awarded, the Vice Rector of the Campus, after consulting with Confindustria Piacenza, may decide to re-announce a call for applications for the same academic year (graduates in the March 2025 session) or for the next academic year.

The recipient may be invited to a meet-and-greet with the donor.

Art. 4 - General reference rules

Accumulation: the scholarship may be accumulated with other forms of financial assistance granted by Politecnico for the academic year to which this call refers, and Politecnico or other public or private entities disburse grants for international mobility



purposes. The scholarship may also be combined with exemptions from mandatory university fees and contributions.

Revocation: the scholarship may be revoked if disciplinary sanctions are brought against the beneficiary.

Withdrawal: if the successful applicant opts out of the scholarship or if the necessary forms are not returned by the relevant deadline, the next eligible applicant in the ranking will be assigned the scholarship instead.

Allocation: the winner will be notified of the award of the scholarship to his/her official University e-mail address. Within 10 days of receiving this notification, the recipient must return the relevant forms attached to the award notification, signed for acceptance. The scholarship will be paid in a lump sum by Politecnico di Milano – Piacenza Campus -

only after submitting the enrolment certificate to a Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) programme at Politecnico di Milano and submission of the paper documentation proving the truthfulness of the declared Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator.

Taxation: monies awarded are subject to taxation, in accordance with applicable scholarship rules. The scholarship award is treated as employment income, and is therefore treated in the same way for tax purposes. The costs borne by Politecnico di Milano correspond to the IRAP (regional tax on productive activities) rate of 8.5% of the scholarship award.

Self-certification of data: if Politecnico di Milano should discover that false declarations have been made, any benefits received will be forfeited.

Art. 5 - Personal data processing

Politecnico di Milano will process personal data in the manner detailed in the privacy notice at the end of this call, in accordance with regulation EU 679/2016.

Art. 6 - Head of the procedure

PRIVACY POLICY PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 13 OF THE EUROPEAN GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)

Politecnico of Milan (hereafter also Politecnico), in the role of the Data Controller, based at Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan - General Management, hereby informs you of the methods for processing your personal data, in compliance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and the respective implementing regulation (hereafter also Regulation). The Processor of the data provided by you is the Department Manager of the Piacenza Campus.

A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

The following data constitute personal data belonging to you which have been collected and processed by Politecnico: (a) data that you communicated upon registration or enrolment, such as your name, surname, date and place of birth, gender, tax code, nationality, residential address, telephone and email contact details, educational qualifications; (b) data collected when you submitted your application on the relevant application form.

B. DATA PROCESSING PURPOSES AND METHODS

Your personal data may be processed for the following purposes: 1) for the public interest purpose of verifying the requirements for participation in the call for applications based on the criteria set forth in this call, and for all other legal purposes, including statistical purposes. In relation to the aforementioned purposes, Politecnico di Milano will process said data, using manual and electronic instruments and means, only insofar as such data is relevant and the data processing is limited to the purposes for which they were initially collected and, in any case, in a manner that ensures the data can be kept absolutely secure and confidential, and always in full compliance with applicable rules in force.

C. MANDATORY OR VOLUNTARY NATURE OF THE DATA PROVISION

The provision of data for the purposes indicated in section B 1 is mandatory; any refusal to provide such data will result in the inadmissibility of the application and immediate exclusion from the procedure.

D. SCOPE OF COMMUNICATION AND CIRCULATION OF THE DATA

Your personal data will be communicated to Politecnico employees who are authorised to process those data, namely natural or legal persons who work with Politecnico to implement the procedures for the selection and assignment of the award under this call.

E. STORAGE AND POSSIBLE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA

Your personal data will be stored at Politecnico di Milano and will not be transferred to a third country.

F. DATA RETENTION PERIOD

Your personal data will be retained only for as long as strictly necessary in order to meet the requirements of this call for applications, unless it becomes necessary to retain and store the data for a longer period in the public interest. If the data are stored for longer periods, Politecnico guarantees compliance with the data minimisation principle under Art. 89, point 1 of the Regulation.

G. YOUR RIGHTS

We remind you that you have the right to obtain information on the methods by which your data are processed and any other information envisaged by Art. 15 of the Regulation (known as right of access) - to obtain the rectification of inaccurate personal data relating to you, pursuant to Art. 16 of the Regulation (known as right to rectification) - to restrict the processing of your personal data in accordance with Art. 18 of the Regulation (known as right to restriction of processing); - to object to the processing of your personal data in the cases and according to procedures indicated in Art. 21 of the Regulation (so-called right to object)
